FIU ADMISSIONS: NOT A SAFETY?



- Now ONLY on the Common App, no institutional application.
- No more rolling admissions: students must apply by their deadlines:
 - Early Action/Scholarship Deadline: November 1 (last ACT: 9/14, last SAT 10/4)
 - Regular Deadline: December 3 (last ACT: 10/25, last SAT: 11/2)
- Students must send official test scores from collegeboard or ACT,
 CLT website.
- Admission to a pathway (or term) is final
- Students applying for early action will either be accepted or denied, no deferrals will be given.

FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY

- Early Action Deadline: October 15th, SSAR due: October 22nd
- Regular Deadline: December 1st, SSAR due: December 8th
- Applicants can now choose between being considered for their preferred admission term OR, be considered for both fall and summer terms.
- Can now select if you are interested in being considered for different "Seminole Pathways"
 - This does NOT mean that you will be overlooked for your preferred term, just saying that you would consider other options
 - Recommended to select this option if FSU is your top choice

FSU PATHWAYS

- FSU International Programs-1st semester abroad
 OR 1st year abroad
- FSU Panama City Campus
- FSU Next Program (Spring Transfer):
 - Can participate in FSU events and clubs (not Greek life)
 - Take 1st semester at Tallahasse State College (previously TCC)
 and one course at FSU: "Gateway to Garnet & Gold"
 - Start full-time at FSU in January

UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA

- Early Action Deadline: November 1st, SSAR & test scores due: November 15th
- Regular Deadline: January 15th, SSAR & test scores due: January 31st
- Considered to PACE program if you apply to a PACE-eligible major
 - PACE: 1st 2 semesters are completely online, can come to campus after 2nd year.
 - If you are graduating with your AA, apply as a regular student, then if you get denied, can reapply as transfer student

ADDITIONAL UPDATES

FAU:

• Early action deadline: November 1st, then rolling admissions



• Must apply before January 15th for scholarship consideration

FGCU:

Students graduating with their AA can apply without test scores



USF:

- Early action deadline: November 1st, SSAR due November 15th (recommended for preferred campus)
- Last SAT/ACT considered are the December exams
- Must apply before January 15th for scholarship consideration

ACT UPDATES IN 2025

- Shorter exam: shorter reading and English passages and fewer questions
- Science and writing will now be optional sections
- Students can choose to take the exam on paper or digitally
- Test will now be about 2 hours





What are these colleges looking at? Are they really taking a holistic view of applications?

- Yes... and no. State universities seem to put a large emphasis on the SAT/ACT
- They also look at:
 - GPA (FL schools recalculate your weighted GPA, including just your core classes)
 - Extracurriculars (consistent involvement in school, family, and/or community)
 - Essays & supplemental questions (if applicable)
 - Strength of your curriculum
 - Academic growth over time

WHY ARE STATE SCHOOLS SO COMPETITIVE?

- Increasing number of applicants
- Affordability
 - Low tuition costs, compared to other out-of-state or private universities
 - Bright Futures Scholarship
 - Florida Prepaid Program
- Top-ranked schools
